

CSL Annual Report for 2018-2019 sabbatical leaves

The CSL received and considered 36 applications for sabbatical leave to be taken during 2020-2021. Prior to the final meeting of the eleven-member committee, each committee person was assigned approximately 10 applications to review and rank. The rankings were combined to establish the committee's composite ranking of the applications from 1 to 36. The CSL met on Wednesday, October 23 to discuss the rankings and recommendations regarding each application. Professor Joanna Slusky served as chair of the committee.

The final ranked list reflected the decisions made during this committee meeting. Although some of the applications were judged stronger than others, the Committee felt that each of the approved applications had considerable merit.

As part of the evaluation process, a primary reviewer was assigned to each applicant and asked to write a narrative paragraph. These were reviewed by the Committee chair. The Committee hopes that the written evaluations of each proposal and applicant provided the UCSL with helpful information for its deliberations. All 36 applicants were granted sabbatical leave by the UCSL.
