- Reviews and provides recommendations to the full committee on proposals for new graduate degrees and concentrations, graduate certificate proposals, graduate certificate renewals

Role of the Committee

- Reviews the annual Dean's Charges and prepares response/report for endorsement by the full committee
- Reviews and provides recommendations to the full committee for proposed new policies or policy changes governing graduate education in the College
- Reviews and responds to select student petitions seeking relief from College or Graduate Studies policies.
