**Rationale for Course Proposal** ENGL 898 will differentiate an MA student from those who take the MA Exam (ENGL 897), and those who craft an MA Thesis (ENGL 899). The department hopes adding the portfolio option will reduce the time to degree of the majority of MA students. Currently, MA students in the program typically take 2.5 to 3 years to finish; adding ENGL 898 will enable students to complete their degree in 2 years.
