Minutes of the Meeting for January 28, 2020

Chair's Welcome: Professor Slusky called the meeting to order at 11:15 am.

Approval of CUSA Minutes: A motion was made to approve the December 10, 2019 meeting minutes of the Committee on Undergraduate Studies & Advising. The motion was seconded and passed unanimously.

Dean's Office Update: Associate Dean Storkel reported that a pre-proposed form has been developed for proposing new programs. This pre-proposal form will be required for all new program proposals effective immediately. Associate Dean Storkel also updated the committee on the College Dean transition and the Associate Dean searches. Interim Provost Lejeuz will remain in the Provost's office until July. After July, he will return as Dean of the College. The searches for an Associate Dean will begin in the middle of this semester. Lastly, Associate Dean Storkel reported that in conjunction with the new budget model, the provost's office is reviewing new course proposals to ensure that schools are maintaining disciplinary oversight.
