Chair's Welcome: Professor Slusky called the meeting to order at 11:17 am.

Approval of CUSA Minutes: A motion was made to approve the March 24, 2020 meeting minutes of the Committee on Undergraduate Studies & Advising. The motion was seconded and passed unanimously.

Dean's Office Update: Associate Dean Storkel reported that the Provost has made budget decisions and has communicated those with the schools. Associate Dean Storkel also reported that that CR/NC change has been enacted for the Spring 2020 semester. Summer 2020 courses will be taught online. Course offerings have been updated in the schedule of classes. A decision about Fall 2020 classes will be made soon.
